Drag-and-Drop Video Assets

Add Assets to Timeline

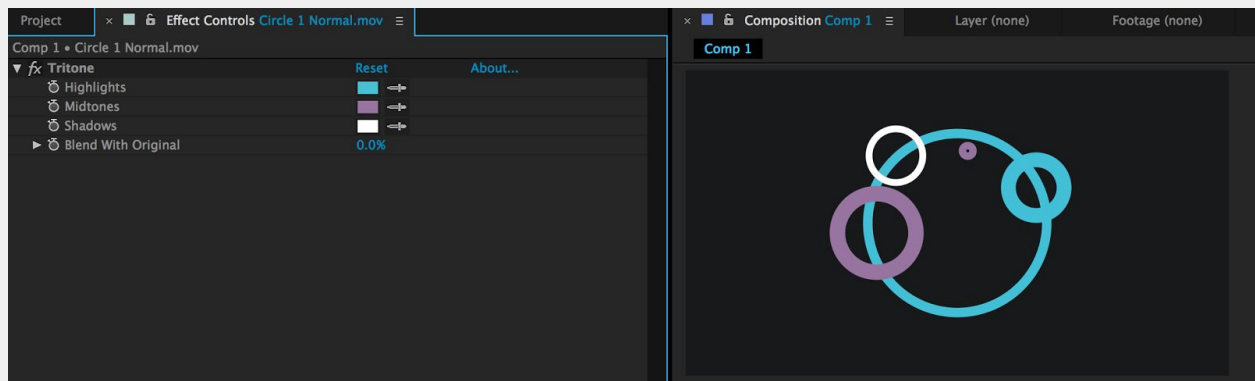
Launch After Effects and import the Circle Burst assets. You can drag the assets into your composition like any other footage. The assets contain an alpha channel, so there is no need to key out the footage.

Colorize as Needed

In the effects panel, type in 'Tritone' and drag the effect onto your desired circle burst asset.



By adjusting each tritone color, you will adjust a corresponding asset color in the circle burst animation.

Note: Some assets only feature two colors.
